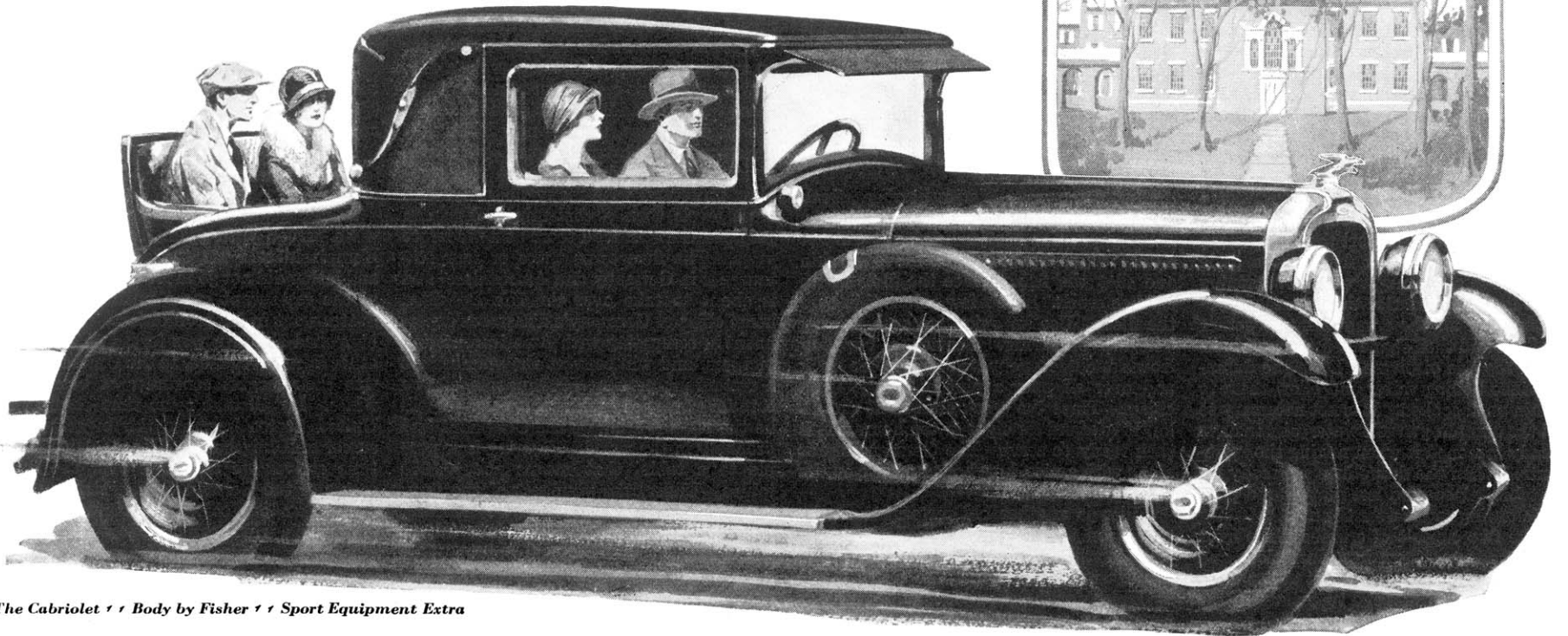
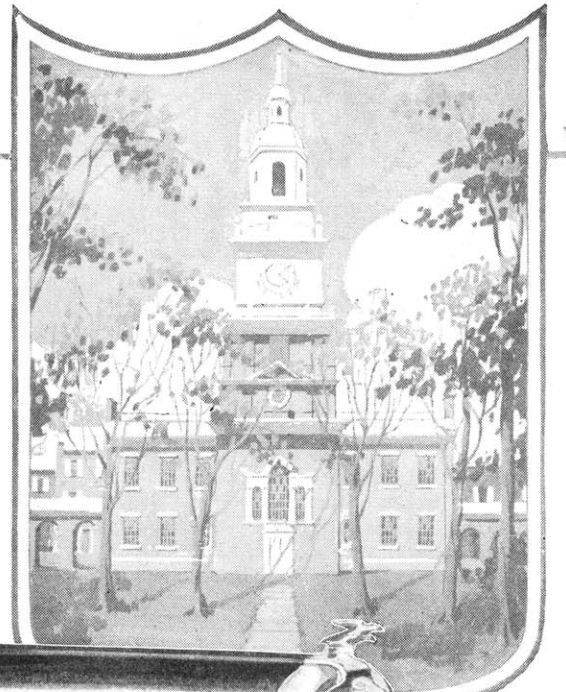




*Independence Hall in Philadelphia where the Declaration of Independence was signed. It is now used as a museum in which relics of Revolutionary days are exhibited.*
