

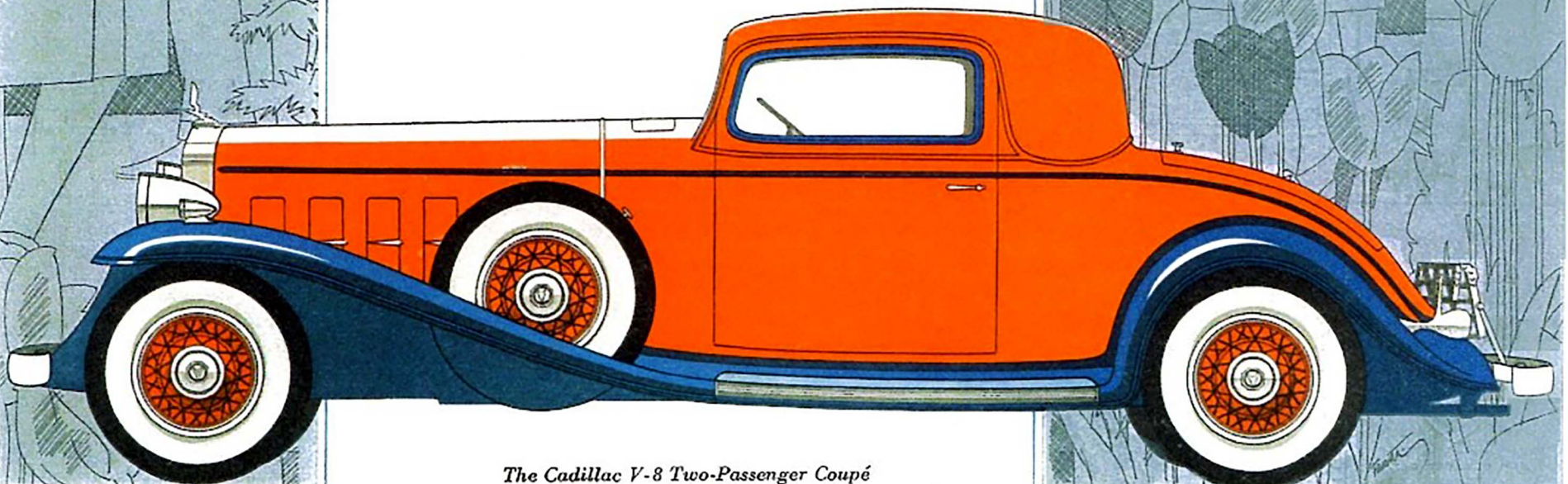
Standard  of the World
