




Dashboard is reworked 1948 Studebaker over stock dash. Wheel is 1940 Ford




Front end is all chrome; front wheels are '50 Merc, shocks from '50 Lincoln

Custom interior by De Nick of Oakland has pipe roll liner and matching seat




Full house 286 ci Merc carries Potvin cam, Weber crank. Bumper is homemade
