*On the pole with hot 'T' and scowl to match, Roy Richter, present day owner of Bell Auto Parts and Cragar speed equipment, shown prior to half-mile dirt track victory at the old Lacy Field track in East Los Angeles. He wiped them out that day with his 183-cubic inch '26 Ford sporting Rajo 8-valve overhead setup, Ruckstell two-speed rear end and Muncie four-speed box. Custom-made Mercury dropped axle mounted Buffalo wire wheels. A little later he became deeply involved in building and driving beautiful midjets of pre-war era, was noted for his workmanship on Sam Hanks' fine Offy. Roy still 'hot laps' the Lacy site; it's now part of Santa Ana freeway, he commutes in Corvair Monza.*
