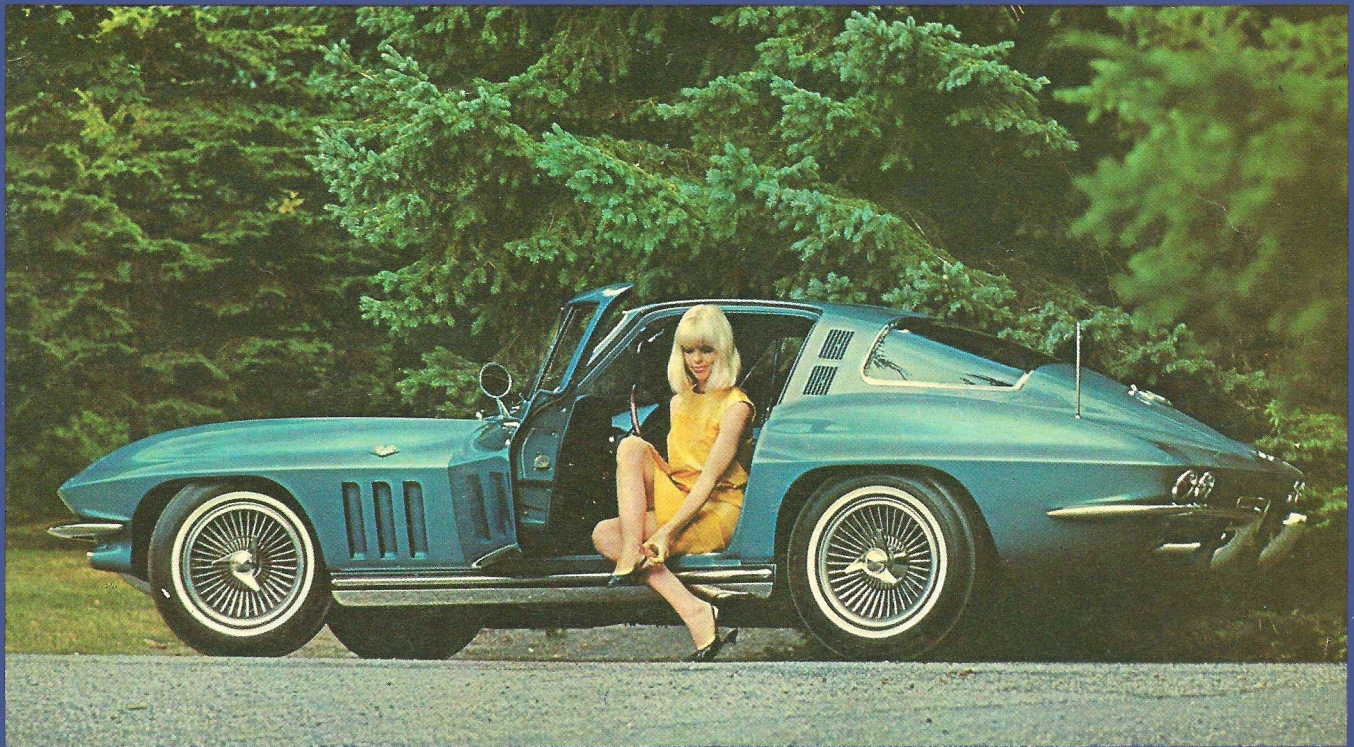
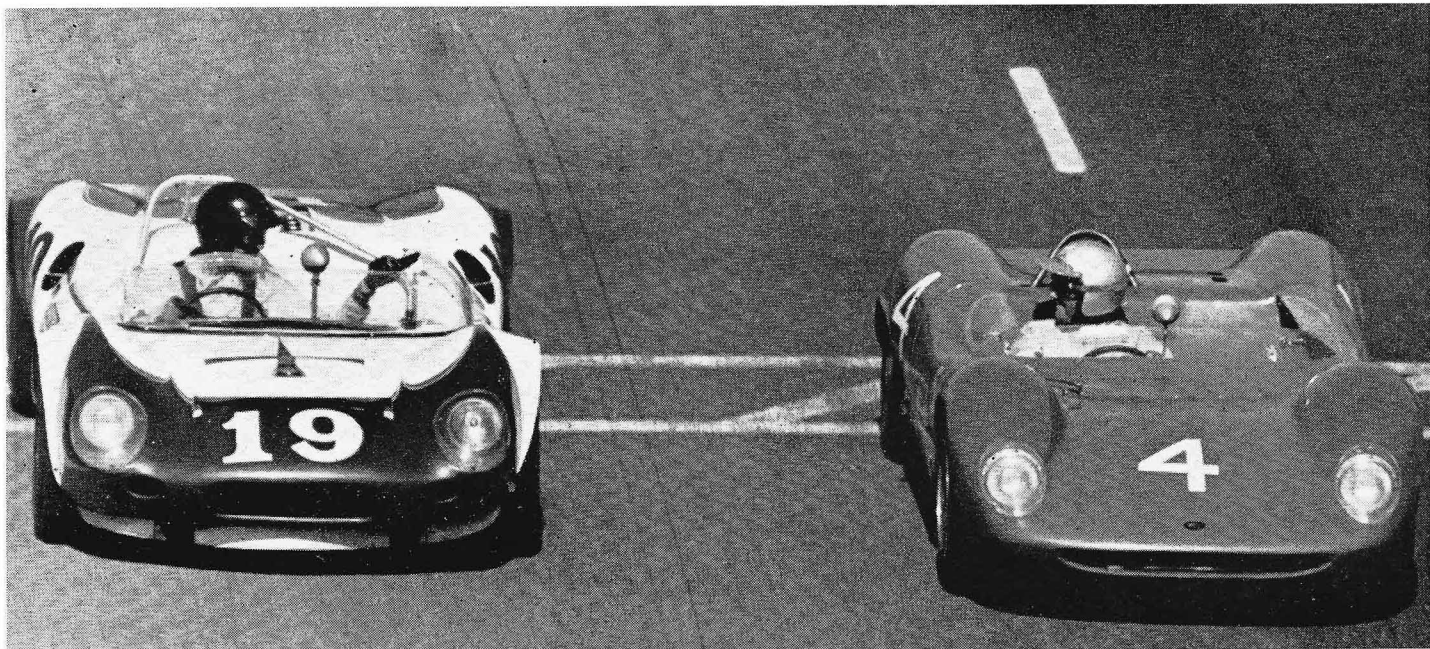

Dapper Dan Gurney gestures significantly (in the British manner) to Smilin' Jack Brabham at Riverside (see page 53)

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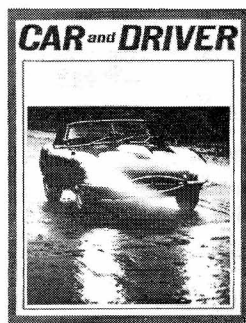
